In order to meet these objectives, McMahon Services will implement these measures;

- McMahon Services will ensure the systematic identification and assessment of OHS risks;
- McMahon Services will develop and implementing joint initiatives for the purpose of improving and sustaining good OHS performance;
- McMahon Services senior management and employees will all have allocated responsibilities and accountabilities in the implementation OHS management system for areas over which they have control;
